This document should be referenced when creating any piece of text for Fieldpartner International, such as:

- Social media statuses
- Infographics
- Articles and subtitles

This article can also be sent to freelancers when outsourcing transcription, writing or other services.

Punctuation

- FieldPartner International (FieldPartner should be at one single word, with a capital P in the middle, and the first letter of both words should be capitalized)
- Cross-culture/Cross-cultural: there should be a hyphen between the two words
- Any references to God should have its first letter capitalized. This includes God/Him/His/Holy Spirit

Names

These are the names of the people working on Fieldpartner International.

In addition, some of the sermons include Bible characters. When outsourcing transcriptions, It is important to state the correct spelling of these characters' names.

Bible Versions

Unless otherwise stated, the NKJV version of the Bible is used, and if it is in printed form (article or infographics), it should be cited accordingly.

Citations

Any Bible verses should be cited with the proper version. Any copyrighted material should also be cited.
